

Salvagine SARS-CoV-2 Task Force: Hopeful signs - but there is still a long way to go.

We have been operating our Trendometer for many months now and it is astonishing to see how right the predictions have been so far. Changes in vaccine projects and in rapid antigen tests were also predicted correctly.

The current lockdowns are already becoming a lot smarter, more localized and being implemented earlier than before. This promises less damage to the economy, and we think, that by spring 2021, there will be a big improvement of the situation in the northern hemisphere. This is also due to the very good vaccine projects, especially the mRNA-based one from BioNTech, and the effective localization of infection herds with rapid antigen tests.

For the winter, we expect more or less M-shaped waves in the north. Being momentarily at the peak with the highest number of infected people, we expect Europe to be the first to show a slightly falling number of infections in the next days, which will

show its lowest point by the end of January or February. This will reduce the number of infections in Spring significantly. We expect the same development in the US, but with a 4-6 weeks delay as the number of infections is currently still rising significantly.

The extent to which this development will present itself depends very much on the political decisions and how smart the lockdown measures are. A very bad example right now is one of the richest and furthest developed countries in the world, Switzerland, which surprisingly brought the health system to collapse due to its less smart decisions.

For the southern hemisphere, especially for Brazil, South Africa and parts of Australia, we see the predictions for spring as less optimistic. It will all come down to how their winter develops and if there will be a program of vaccination for the broad population. Overall, we see a significant improvement for the entire year 2021 and we will have a much more "normal" life again. The outlook for Autumn 2021 is therefore much more positive due to us being better prepared. However, as we can see in the Trendometer, the vast majority of questions are still to be answered and the two most important ones from our point of view are: how safe are the various vaccines and how long lasts the resulting immunity.

In the current climate and amid the flood of information in the news, it is often difficult to sift out the really useful and reliable facts about SARS-CoV-2 and the resulting lung disease, Covid-19. While the media provide us with partly contradictory information, previous public statements are being revised as new knowledge comes to light. There is only one thing we can be sure about in these unprecedented times: we still don't know everything about the novel coronavirus. But we are learning something new all the time and steadily increasing our knowledge about possible treatments, about immunity and about potential vaccines, so that we are now in a place, where we can give recommendations for preventions and health support during the pandemic.

But as everybody's situation and individual risk factors (age, medical history, place of residence etc.) are different, it is very
